For children residential trips for schools offer a unique opportunity for them to claim their independence and make their own decisions.

We will be leaving school on Monday morning at 9.10am. Children are invited to attend breakfast club on this day. They will require a packed lunch for Monday only, all other meals will be provided. Below is a timetable and kit list which is required for the visit:

### Timetable

**Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September** – Children will spend their morning at White Scar Caves, Ingletton. After lunch the children will visit Wensleydale Creamery for a tour of the Creamery, cheese making and tasting. They will then spend some time cray fishing at the river Wharfe near Kettlewell. They will then arrive at Halton Gill Bunk Barn, Littondale, to enjoy their evening meal and then an evening walk along the river next to the barn.

**Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> September** – Visit to Linton Falls, walk to Burnsall along the River Wharfe. Lunch on the village green. Then children will visit Kilnsey trout farm and pony trekking centre. Then on to Grassington for ice cream and a look round the shops. The evening activity will be a quiz on what the children have learned during the day.

**Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September** – Visit to Hill Top Farm in Malham. Followed by lunch and a visit to Malham Cove. (children will be back at school for 3.00pm).
