Scenario 1 (based on current restrictions):

- Assembly will take place on school playground
- Parents will be socially-distanced and each household will be allocated a mat
- Parents are welcome to bring their own cushions/ foldaway chairs
- Maximum of two adults per child

Scenario 2 (should restrictions be sufficiently lifted to enable parents on site and indoors):

- Assembly will take place in the school hall
- Maximum of two adults per child

Scenario 3 (in the event of current restrictions and severe weather)

- Assembly will take place in the school hall
- Parents and carers will be unable to attend
- One year group will be invited to watch the assembly
- Event will be recorded and a copy provided to parents and carers

So, please keep your fingers crossed and hope for a further lifting of restrictions or some unusually warm, sunny weather!
