Headteacher's Message



In June I wrote to you regarding a proposed change to the structure of the school day here at Worth Valley Primary School. This was:

• **To change the end time of the school day to 15:20. It is currently 15:00.**

The Government have recommended that schools are open for a minimum of 32.5 hours per week. Most schools are open for this length of time with only about 14% of schools not. It is equivalent to 08:50-15:20 Monday to Friday. This change of twenty minutes per day will ensure that our school is in line with Government recommendations and the majority of schools in this country.

The consultation has now closed on the proposed changes to the structure of the school day here at Worth Valley Primary School. Thank you for your input; we are pleased that the response has been positive and those changes will now be implemented from September.

Due to staffing capacity, transition day has been rescheduled to Wednesday 13 July. In the meantime, I am pleased to share with you your child's teachers and support staff for next academic year:

Please complete the ticket information slip at the bottom of the letter and return to the school office by Monday 18 July.

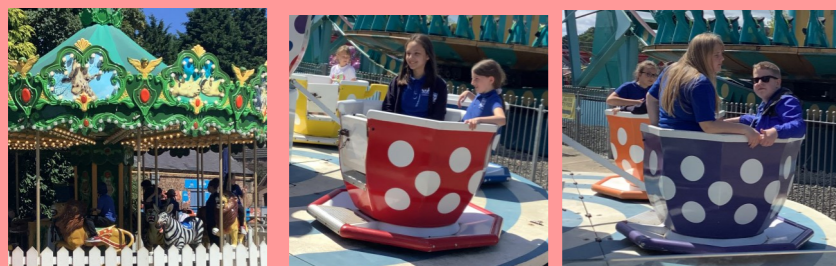
Sports Day
