On **Friday 5 May** we will be celebrating the King's Coronation.

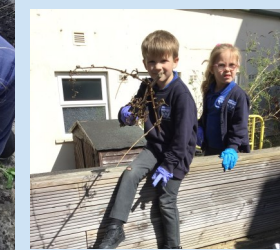

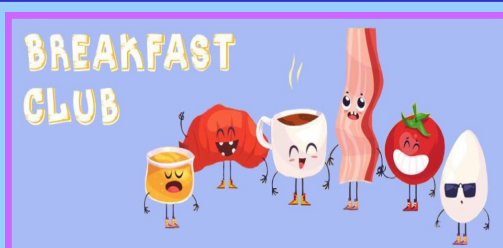
Attendance is recorded for each class on a weekly basis.
