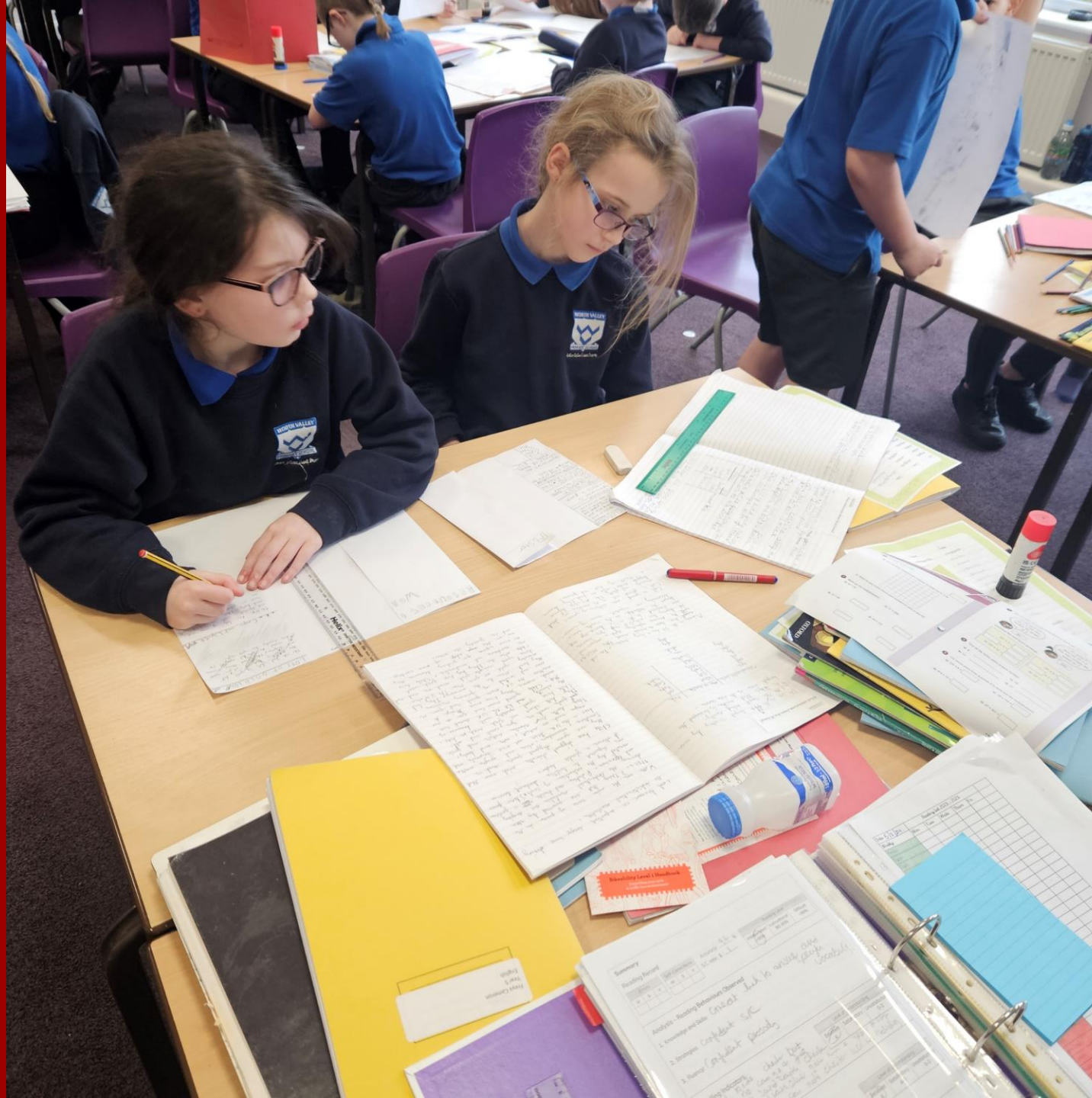
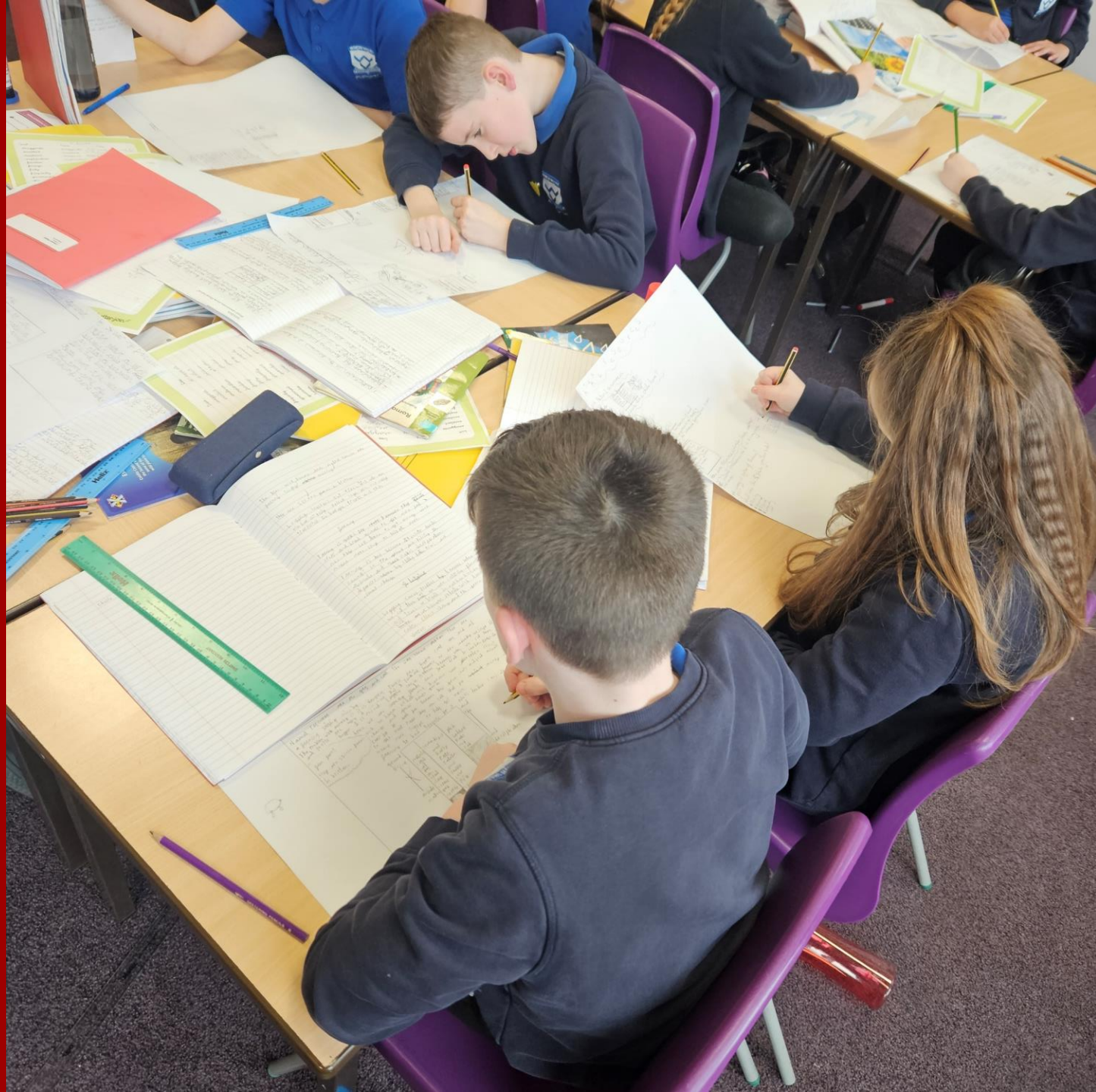

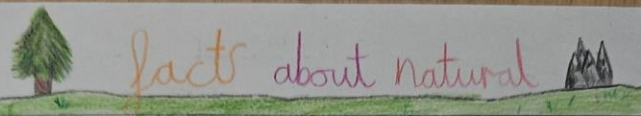

The war of the Pacific

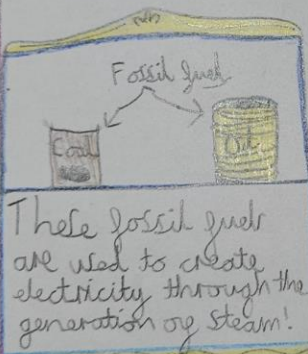

Agriculture crops and live stock. Sheep, oats, pig, cow, wheat, agricultural, barley, potatoes, chicken and the last one is leather.

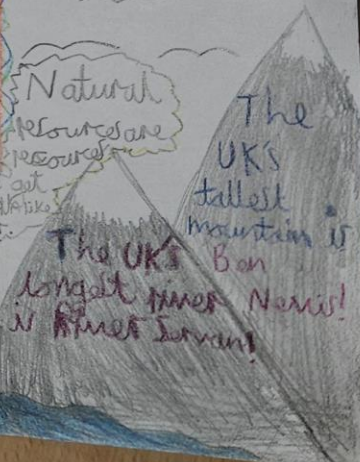

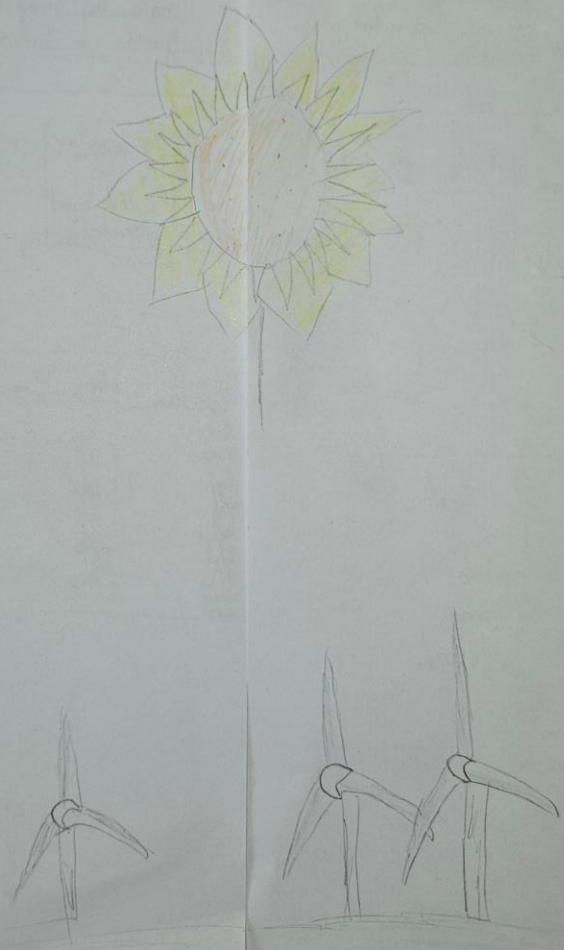
