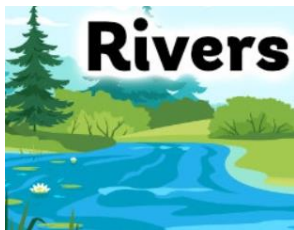


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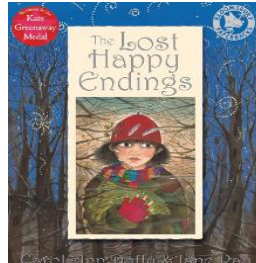
What are we learning in Year 4?



Rivers

Geography

In Geography, we will focus on understanding the importance of rivers and the water cycle, and their impact on the landscape.



English

In English, we are practising our grammar, punctuation and handwriting skills to improve our writing. We will be using our class text as inspiration to carefully select interesting vocabulary in our work.



Maths

In Maths we will be recognising the place value of 4-digit numbers, rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 and comparing and ordering numbers.



Computing

The children begin to understand selection in computing programs and explore number variables and coordinates in programming.



PHSE

In Me and My Relationships, we explore feelings and emotions, develops skills to manage conflict, helping the children to identify people who are special to them.



Art

Using mechanical engravings as a starting point, pupils develop an awareness of proportion, composition and pattern in drawing and combine media for effect when developing a drawing into a print.



Science

In Animals Including Humans, we learn how to describe the functions of the parts of the digestive system in humans, to identify the different types of teeth in humans and their function and to construct and interpret a variety of food chains.



Music

The children will be learning to listen to changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics and relate it to something tangible and familiar. Linking to their geography learning, the pupils will represent different stages of the river through vocal and percussive arrangements.
